Frog and toad types

There are more than 4500 different types of frogs and toads in the world. These are divided into 28 groups called families.

Tree frogs
Tree frogs are found in many countries around the world. This type of frog has a slender body, long legs and lives in trees. Its fingers and toes end in sticky pads that help it to cling to branches without slipping off. Tree frogs are nocturnal, which means they are active at night.

Clawed frogs
Clawed frogs spend their whole life in water. Unlike other frogs, which catch food with their tongues, clawed frogs put food into their mouth with their fingers. This is because they do not have a tongue.

Two lumps
There are many types of toad, and most live on dry land for much of the year. Most toads, such as the common toad, have two lumps on their head, behind their eyes. If attacked, these ooze a foul liquid, which is sometimes poisonous.

A common toad oozes toxins when confronted by a viper.

Tree frogs spend their entire lives in trees.

Frog and toad fact!
The fire-bellied toad has a red belly with black spots. When threatened, it flips up its back and exposes its red belly. It does this to scare away predators.

Glass frogs have see-through skin, which means you can see the organs inside their body.
