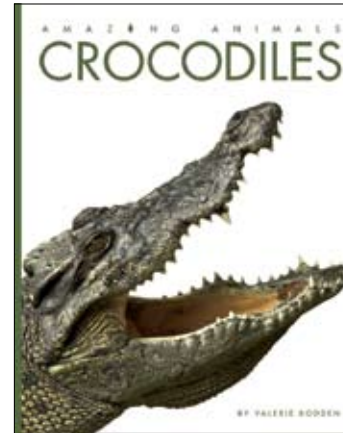

Big Outdoors

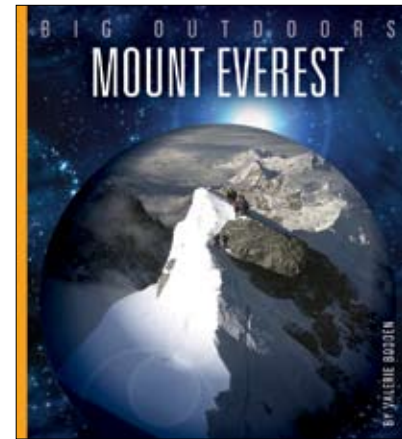
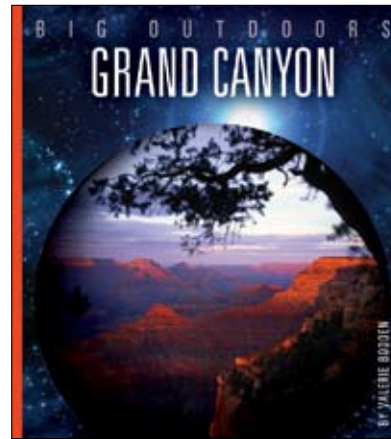

FOOD FOR LIFE

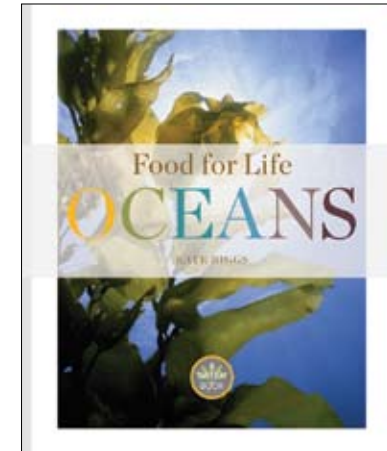
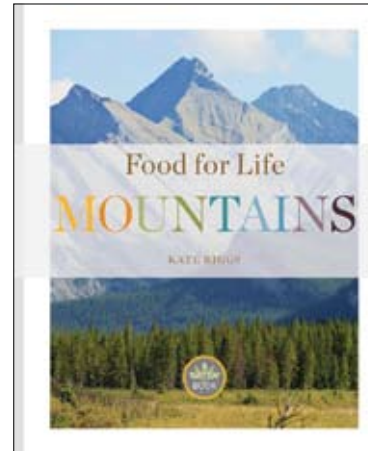
