






GUIDELINES FOR BOOKMARKS

My Road to Reading bookmarks support young readers and families as they move step by step through the My Road to Reading program. With built-in progress tracking and a clear sequence of skills, bookmarks make the road visible and easy to follow.

The My Road to Reading Bookmark Provides:

-  A clear and easy-to-follow progression of skills
-  A visual way to track progress
-  A guide for what to read next



1 Initial Sounds

Readers check off each step as they complete it, creating visible progress they can see and celebrate.

2 Short Vowels

Each bookmark includes a space for the child to write their name, building a sense of ownership and pride in their reading journey.

3 Consonant Blends

The bookmark also includes a QR code that links directly to MyRoadToReading.com, where families can access guides and step-by-step video support.

Using My Road to Reading Bookmarks

Keep bookmarks at the circulation desk or in a clearly labeled, easy-to-access spot near the My Road to Reading display so staff can quickly grab one at checkout and families can see that they are part of the program.

Provide a bookmark when a child first checks out My Road to Reading books. This is the starting point of their journey. For returning readers, ask if they have their bookmark and offer a replacement if needed.
