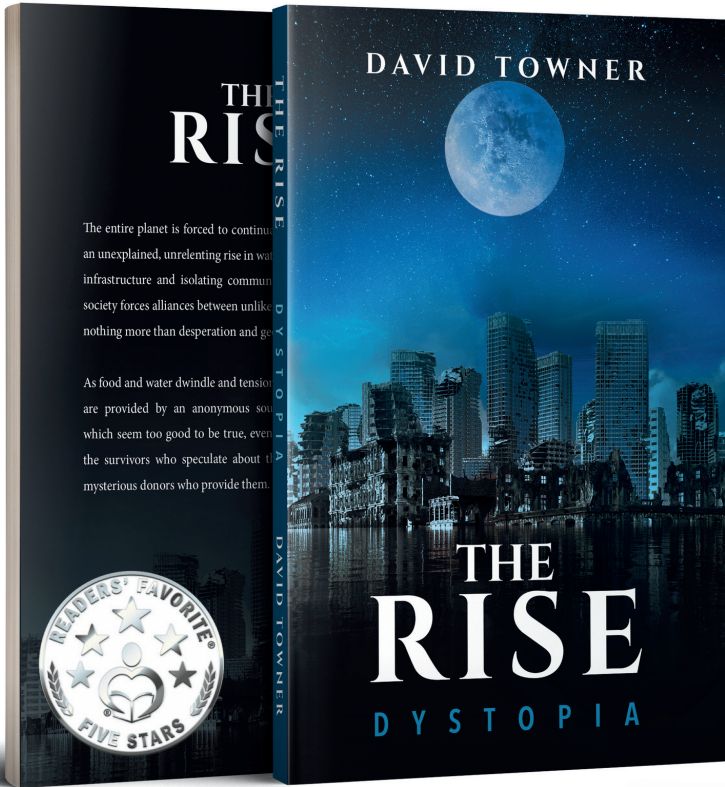


THE RISE : DYSTOPIA (BOOK ONE)
